NO DAY TO DAY GARBAGE ALLOWED!

8:00 AM to 12:00 PM - Olson Sanitation will be here to help rid your household items, such as small bikes, books, toys, etc.

11:00 AM to 1:00 PM - The County will also be here to rid your bigger appliances, electronics, tires, etc.

* **Appliances** - \$10 (air conditioner; dehumidifier; refrigerator/freezer; stove/range/oven; microwave; dishwasher; washer/dryer; trash compactor; garbage disposal; water heater; heat pump; furnace).

* **TV/Monitor/Flat Screen** - \$10 each

* **DVD Player/VCR/Stereo Equipment** - FREE

* **Mattress/Box Frame** - \$10/per piece

* **Computer Tower** - FREE

* **Fluorescent bulbs/tubes** - \$.50 per bulb

* **Tires** - Car/light truck \$3 • Large truck \$5 • Semi/small tractor \$20 • Large tractor/heavy equipment \$75

Please note: they will not be taking hazardous household chemical or paint. We will be collecting items from city residents only.

HEAVY HAULERS

The Heavy Haulers are an additional service; please donate according to the amount of what they are hauling and how difficult it is to get it to the site. All donations should be paid to the Fire Relief Association and are greatly appreciated. Please be prepared for the Heavy Haulers prior to their arrival. Heavy Haulers will be very careful, however, they are not responsible for damage. They are great volunteers trying to be helpful.

FREE YARD WASTE DISPOSAL

The Public Works Department is ready to help with your spring clean-up efforts. They will pick brush and leaves. Leaves and lawn trash must be bagged. Brush and branches cannot exceed 6 feet.
