COUNCIL VACANCY—MAYOR POSITION

The City of Clarkfield is accepting applications from citizens interested in an appointment to fill the remaining term of a council position. The term will expire on December 31, 2018.

The Council may appoint any individual who is eligible for election to the office of City Council. To be eligible a person must be a U.S. citizen, a resident of the City and at least 21 years of age. The Council is not obligated to appoint any candidate previously defeated in an election for the office (MN Const. Article VII subd.6)

Applications forms are due by Tuesday, October 17, 2017 at 4:00 PM, and are available at the City Administration Office or by calling (320) 669-4435. Applications will be reviewed prior to making the appointment to fill the position.
